The Venue

Castle Head is located in beautiful South Cumbria between the coast of Morecambe Bay and the Lake District National Park. With access to both the coastline of Morecambe Bay, the glaciated uplands of the southern Lake District and the lakes of Windermere and Coniston, Castle Head is ideally situated for a wide range of outdoor learning activities.







Accommodation: Comfortable accommodation for up to **160 guests** in a mix of dormitories and en-suite rooms.

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The Adventure Package
