The Venue

Located on the Isle of Cumbrae, FSC Millport has a rich history as a marine research station. Since becoming a field centre, purpose-built accommodation has been created to provide an excellent base for a range of programmes. The Centre is easily reached in just 10 minutes by ferry from the mainland at Largs.







All bedrooms are en-suite singles, twin or triple, all bedding is provided. There is a common room and games room for students and hot and cold drinks are accessible around the centre. All meals are included from evening meal on day 1 through to packed lunch on day 3. There is also a small tuck shop on-site that sells drinks, snacks, and souvenirs of the visit.

WIFI: Free WIFI is available through-out the centre.
