
## Our City Tour Package – How Does it work?

## Your Accommodation

**YHA Manchester** is a modern, purpose-built youth hostel located in the historic Castlefield area, just a 10-minute walk from Manchester city centre, offering en-suite accommodation and a wide range of facilities ideal for groups.



### Location

Located next to the Castlefield Basin where the Bridgewater and Rochdale Canals converge, the area provides a historic and picturesque setting and is close to some of Manchester's best group friendly attractions including the Museum of Science and Industry, People's History Museum and Mamucium Roman Fort.

### Accommodation

The hostel features **37 en-suite rooms** across 3 floors with a total **152 beds**, rooming includes 2-bed, 4-bed, 5-bed, and 6-bed configurations, each with secure key card entry.

### Facilities and Services

Social spaces include a cafe, canal-side restaurant, communal seating areas and a games room providing a vibrant social space for guests.

### Accessibility

Wheelchair-accessible facilities, secure key card entry, and 24-hour reception ensure a safe and convenient stay.

## Manchester Art Gallery



# What's on the menu?

This residential tour package includes: a full board meals service – covering breakfast, evening meal and packed lunches. (Groups provide own packed lunch for day 1).

Group leaders are provided with comprehensive packed lunch & evening meal choice forms ahead of the visit to allow participants to make their own choices from the relevant menus. This provides the opportunity to highlight any specific dietary information that the team will need to know in advance.



**Breakfast** is a buffet arrangement with guests choosing items from a range of food (sausage, bacon, scrambled eggs, hash browns, beans, tomatoes, continental pastries, cereals, yoghurt & fruit juices). There are always vegetarian and vegan options available.

**Packed lunches** consist of a sandwich, piece of fruit and additional snack which are picked up after breakfast. We ask all participants to bring a refillable water bottle with them for use throughout the visit. This helps us to reduce the waste created by single-use plastics.

**Evening meals** vary in choice on different days, but you will be sent a menu prior to your visit where you will be able to choose from two to three main meals and deserts.
